












Murdered Iraqi Academics and Doctors by Specialty













Distribution of Murders by Type of Institution




Assassinated Medical Professionals in Iraq


<u>Deputy Iraqi Health Minister's Statement</u> (Feb 2006) - Since April 2003:

Q Over 220 doctors have been killed in Iraq






Medical Specialities of Murdered Iraqi Doctors April 2003 - April 2006




Distribution of Assassinations



Distribution Of Assassination by Region




Murdered Iraqi Academics Distribution by Universities from North to South




Other Non-Fatal Incidents


- § Many assassination attempts resulted in the death of other family members and escorts which have not been included or referred to in this study.
- § Multiple assassination attempts are ongoing.
- Separate threats to life are made to force people to leave Iraq.
- S Considerable numbers of threats to life go unreported.
- § In the last week of April 2006, a mass campaign was reported in Mosul of threats to doctors calling on them to leave Iraq.








Temporal Trends in Assassinations






Plight of Iraqi Academics

- § A new phenomena in Iraq,
- **§** Never existed prior to April 2003.
- § The pattern indicates a sinister campaign and motives.
- **§** Similar pattern to EI-Salvador

- The assassinations, kidnaps and threats to life forcing academics and doctors to leave lraq do not follow any religious or sectarian pattern.
- The only dominant pattern is that the absolute majority of victims are ethnically Arabs.
